We are the second largest border crossing between the United States and Canada with approximately six million vehicles crossing the border on an annual basis.

We are currently recruiting and prequalifying applicants for the following U.S. **Full Time Temporary** positions:

- **Toll/Traffic** (collecting tolls on the Canadian side of the border, directing traffic, light janitorial duties) - 32 – 40 hrs. per week.

Every position is conditional upon and maintenance of a valid driver's license, international border crossing security clearance through border agencies, a valid U.S. passport or enhanced driver's license and a Nexus trusted traveler card (ability to acquire a Nexus card if not currently enrolled in the Nexus program).
